Drinking and Driving

Do you drink and drive? Can't stop? In this powerful presentation, Darryl Hagar, "The Man Overboard," tells how he was arrested for driving under the influence *6 times* before he made the emotional U-turn that got his life back on track. Driving while intoxicated is like carrying a bomb in the passenger seat -- disaster can strike at any moment. "I have counseled guys in prison who killed people while drinking and driving and they have to live with it for the rest of their lives," says Darryl. "I'm grateful to God that I did not run over anyone and kill them -- including myself -- while intoxicated. I was incredibly lucky."

This is a must-hear talk for anyone concerned with what can happen after one too many. If your group needs a dynamic speaker who can bring home the danger of drinking and driving once and for all -- someone who will inspire them to never get behind the wheel again when they've been drinking, this presentation fills the bill.
